TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION:

Event open to MEN only. Weigh-in will take place the morning of the event. Mandatory competitor meeting scheduled for 07:30am the morning of the competition. Wrestling shoes and singlets must be worn. Singlets may be any color since a green/red ankle bracelet will be worn for competition that will be provided by venue. Headgear is optional.

BRACKETING: Organizing committee reserves the right to consolidate weight and/or age divisions based on number of competitors. Technical Rule changes, if any, will be explained prior to competition. Double elimination, three one minute rounds, and a 30 second overtime sudden victory if necessary.

DIVISIONS: OPEN – 18 and over, SENIOR – 30 TO 39 and MASTER – 40 and Above

Eligibility:

All sworn Federal, State/Provincial, County, Municipal and Military law enforcement officers, weight control officers, corrections officers and dispatchers employed by a law enforcement agency. Police reservists and cadets who have 180-days of continuous law enforcement service, have received formal training in law enforcement and have powers of arrest are eligible.

Eligible fire service personnel includes both paid and volunteer, dispatchers, military fire personnel, (male, active or retired) who have received formal training as a firefighter and have 180-days of continuous fire service.

Eligible EMS personnel includes E.M.S. personnel employed by a private entity or Governmental Agency (male, active or retired) who have received formal training as an EMS provider and have 180 days of continuous service.

Eligible law enforcement, fire service and E.M.S. personnel described above from any city, county, state/province, and Country are eligible to compete.

Spouses of eligible law enforcement, fire service and E.M.S. personnel are also eligible to compete. A spouse must complete a Registration Form listing the agency information representing the eligible spouse.
